

# STATEMENT OF EXPECTATION

Beechworth Old Cranks Motor Club Inc.

While all people with an interest in our hobby are encouraged to consider membership with the club, there is a certain expectation that the club has of all members. The committee of The Beechworth Old Cranks Motor Club Inc. would encourage all current & prospective members to observe the following expectations:

1. All club members are encouraged to attend at least 2 club general meetings per year plus the AGM.
2. All club members should, at some point make themselves available for a formal role in the club, such as a general committee or sub-committee member.
3. All club members who wish to have Club Permit Registration issued by the club for their vehicle must attend at least two official club meetings or functions between January and the AGM. Failure to comply with this requirement will lead to increased club permit fees being payable.
4. All club members who have Club Permit Registration issued by the club for their vehicle must comply with the conditions of that permit as required by VicRoads. The Beechworth Old Cranks Motor Club Inc. is legally responsible for ensuring that members comply with those conditions and reserves the right to recommend to VicRoads that a permit be cancelled due to non-compliance. The member must also disclose all details of their permit to the club secretary on issue of that permit or at any time upon request by the committee.
5. All club members are encouraged to be actively involved in any club organised event or fund raising activity.
6. Those club members who are physically able are encouraged to assist at working bees wherever required.
7. All club members are encouraged to actively promote the club to other enthusiasts and the general public.
8. All club members are encouraged to purchase & wear official club clothing whilst participating in club activities.
9. All club members are encouraged to participate in other activities, such as runs, display, rallies etc., which are organised by similar clubs and organisations.
10. Members should endeavour to present The Beechworth Old Cranks Motor Club Inc., in a positive light wherever possible.

The ten points made above are merely guidelines as to what The Beechworth Old Cranks Motor Club Inc., believes will benefit the club and all members. These points are not legally binding or enforceable, apart from point (4) in regards to the club's legal responsibility to VicRoads
